Next week we will combine science and language arts by starting to read *A Wrinkle in Time* and working more on the structure and plot of our own science fiction stories.

We will be drawing vocabulary words from that, as well as science and social studies for the next month, then we will go back to our spelling books after that again.

Since we had some absences this week, we put off making our brain model until next week. We will be working on that Tuesday morning even if we have some absences. Look for pictures of these colorful brains.

The students really enjoyed the field trip to the Carson Center to see Illuminate. They weren't as keen on the park as they have been in past years, because it seems that many other schools decide that would be a good place for lunch as well.
