I have to warn you that the next few weeks are going to be hectic and busy. November and December always seem to fly by because there are so many things going on. I am pretty sure that this year will prove to be the same.

The first thing that I want to bring up is that we need drivers for the two upcoming field trips. Next week on Wednesday we are going to Castle Park. We will be leaving the school right before noon and leaving the park at 2:45. Yesterday we worked on choosing roles for the play we are doing at the Winter Program and we will start working on that today. We will be working on this and the all-school song until the program.

Students also chose groups to work on our class's miniature castle model. One group is working with a kit and the other is working to make their model using recycled materials and their own imaginations. We will be looking for cardboard and other materials, so contribute what you may feel is useful. We will also be making pomanders, so we need a lot of whole cloves. Have your student bring in as many as possible. Students voted to make apple pie for the Thanksgiving feast. We will need donations of canned apple pie filling and frozen pie crusts.

In ELA we are working on various conventions like capitalization and punctuation. Writing dialog has been our major focus this week. In social studies the students have been working on current events and geography. In math we are covering a variety of topics depending on the student's grade level. All students are working on basic skills. Fourth graders are working on multiplication; fifth graders: writing algebraic expressions; sixth graders: factors and multiples; seventh graders: algebraic expressions and problem solving; and eighth graders: graphing proportional and nonproportional relationships. In science we are still working on elements and atoms.

Be sure to come out Saturday to help with our work day. Remember there is no school on Monday. Thank you for all your help and sharing your wonderful children with me.
